President's Annual Report 2007

Much has happened in the gas industry since the last annual report with numerous acquisitions and change of ownership of many companies. Stakeholders at all levels have realigned. Through all this it has been a pleasure being involved with the IGE in my second year as President.

The Boards continual concern for the growth of our membership has seen a disappointing but expected result as many of the original TAFE award recipients have not renewed their membership and many industry employees have changed employment through 2007. As a result our membership at 31-12-2007 stands at 215, 19 down on the previous year. Not surprising considering the ongoing deferral of the CPD program. I welcome the nine new members who joined the IGE last year.

I am confident however that, with the support of the Board Members and all of our membership, our Institution will face the challenges of 2008 with confidence and be seen to live up to our Mission Statement of "Knowledge in the Gas Industry through Experience and People".

Financial Statement

Whilst the IGE's financial statement appears under matters to be considered during the Annual General Meeting, I would note for your interest that our financial position has remained relatively stable last year. Contributing factors of course has been the reduction in new member intakes and a large number of unpaid fees.

The IGE is a non-profit organisation in that its income is derived mainly from membership subscriptions. If members are slow in paying subscriptions then again, recovery of costs is similarly delayed and exclusion of members for the non-payment of dues also leaves a mark on the bank account.

The Board has acted in the best interest of you, its members, and you may be assured that it will continue to do so. The Board is also very grateful for all the hard work by our Treasurer to ensure good control over our finances.

Outstanding Subscriptions

Outstanding subscriptions leave a dent on our accounts. Despite the most diligent efforts of our Secretary, as at 31-12-2007 there were seventeen (17) outstanding for two (2) years 2005-2006 and thirty one (31) for one (1) year 2006. The Board would greatly appreciate the assistance of our members in clearing these debits. The last option the Board has is to exclude a member for the non-payment of dues, and unfortunately 14 members were excluded in 2007. Continuous Professional Development Program (NSW)

The CPD program has been deferred yet again still pending the outcome of the Licence Review. Your Board however decided to press on with the Seminars. Thanks to Martin de Boer for arranging the Gas Industry Seminar on 25 September 2007
